Spectrum of Views on Communion



Baptist

The bread/wine are **SYMBOLS** that just **REMINDE** us of Jesus's sacrifice for us



Reformed

Nothing happens to the bread and wine, but believers **RECEIVE** the true body/blood of Christ through the Holy Spirit



Lutheran

The bread/wine stay bread and wine, but the body/blood of Christ are **REALLY PRESENT** in, with, and under them



Catholic

The bread and wine change **SUBSTANCE** into the literal body and blood of Christ, but appear the same

FIRST PASSOVER

What did the Israelites have to do? Exodus 12

1. Pick an unblemished male lamb (v5)
2. Sacrifice the Lamb (v6)
3. Dip a bunch of hyssop into the lamb's blood and stain on the wooden door posts/lintel, displaying a "sign of sacrifice" over their homes. (v7, 22)
4. Eat the roasted Lamb whole along with unleavened Matzah bread in a family setting (v8)
5. Keep the Passover as a Day of Remembrance (v14)
